



BUCKDEN WALKERS

2015 SUNDAY SERIES

19 APRIL

Three Villages and two Haws

Meet at the Buck Inn at 10.30am to arrange travel. Distance 5 miles or 9 miles - Usual T&C's

Walk to commence at 11am from the lay-by on the west of the B6265 just above the village duck pond at Rylstone.

The walk forms a figure of eight centred on the villages of Rylstone, Hetton and Flasby; the area is outside the usual realm of dales' walkers but is as pretty as any you will find in the National Park.

The upper loop affords superb views along the Hetton/Flasby Becks - with dippers evident; common buzzards are about in the fields, and flocks of goldfinches and greenfinches feed on the thistle seeds

A return from Flasby to Rylstone completes a walk of 5 miles.

The longer walk proceeds from Flasby in a SE direction along a track through a forestry plantation and gives up views into Airedale and over Gargrave and Skipton. The return leg along an easy going bridleway passes between Rough Haw and Sharp Haw; minor deviations from the route will allow the more challenged to 'top out' either or both at 339M and 357M respectively.




Route Distance: 14.9 km
