I am delighted that soon after my visit a campaign that I have been heavily involved with led to the Education Secretary announcing an extra £1.3 billion in school funding.



GOUTHWAITE RESERVOIR

I had a fascinating trip to Gouthwaite Reservoir to see the important safety work being carried out by Yorkshire Water at a cost of £7 million. The integrity of this dam is vital for the safety of residents in the Pateley Bridge area and even as far as Knaresborough, and I was pleased to see that the work is on track.
