**The Annual Horticultural Show will be held in
Kettlewell Village hall on Sunday 28th August 2016. 1.30 –to-4pm**

The Kettlewell Show was started in 1908, the object being to bring the people in the villages together and take more pride in their gardens, and at first it was purely a competition for the best flower and vegetable garden. The Show was held in the old Kettlewell National School up the hill to Park Rash Road. It was held in a simple marquee in the school grounds. There was a brass band and grand dance in the evening!... Shortly after when the Village Hall was built in 1927 the Show was moved to the Kettlewell hall. The Show lapsed during the two world wars, otherwise it has been held continuously since 1908 bringing the people of the dale together to show off their prowess and admire the results of their labour and skills.

The Village hall will be open for registration of entries on Saturday 27th, 11am to 4pm, and also for late entries on Show Day between 9- 9 30am *only*.

Entry fee: 25p for adults and free for children! But Young adults from 15 years are eligible to enter all the adult classes.

Lots of exciting classes to enter in this years show for all residents within the Kettlewell district, and also lots of classes are 'Open' so visitors, friends and children outside the area will be able to enter and take part in the show and of course 'The Disaster Class'!!!! for anything and everything that went wrong... always popular!
