### Flapjack Recipe

- Line a swiss roll tin [29cm x19cm] with non-stick parchment paper.
- Set oven to 180°C.

#### Ingredients:

- 150 g margarine
- 150g golden syrup
- 1 teaspoon vanilla essence
- 250g porridge oats
- 50g demerara sugar



#### Method:

1. Melt [not boil] the margarine, syrup and vanilla essence.
2. Add oats and stir well.
3. Add the demerara sugar and stir well again.
4. Turn the mixture into the prepared tin, press down, ensuring the mixture is pushed out well into the corners. Smooth over with a palette knife.
5. Bake in a moderate oven [180°C] until golden brown [about 20-25 minutes].
6. Gently cut into squares whilst still hot and allow to cool in the tin.
7. Once cold, cut through your previously marked squares.
8. Store in an air-tight container until required.

### Flapjack Recipe
