Man wanted in connection with theft and fraud North Yorkshire Police are asking for the public's help to find Simon Keith Wilson, 31, from York. Officers want to talk to Mr Wilson about a series of thefts and frauds committed in Whitby, York, Northallerton and Harrogate between December 2014 and February 2015.
