

## Yorkshire chorizo, plum jam and mint sauce now for sale in the shop...



They are both crafted from rare breed pork at Kiplingcotes Farm on the Yorkshire Wolds near Beverley by Jon and Charlotte Clarkson and sold under the award-winning Three Little Pigs brand name.

You can buy a 160g sausage at West Winds for £5.90, below the recommended retail price. Alternatively, why not try one of each? If you mention West Winds News when you buy, a pack of Yorkshire chorizo and another of Yorkshire salami can be yours for a total of £11.50. What's more, you can even try before you buy!

**Plum jam** and **mint sauce**, home-made from our own garden produce, are also now available from the tearoom shop, as well as the usual wide range of chutneys and jellies from Bracken Hill Fine Foods, based near York.

Make your quiche selection from Traditional (with Wensleydale cheese and red onions), Field (with broccoli and courgettes), Forest (with mixed gourmet mushrooms), Spanish (with chorizo sausage and red peppers), English (with bacon, sausage, mushrooms and tomatoes), Mediterranean (with anchovies, olives and capers) and Highland (with Scottish smoked trout and spring onions). And then amaze and delight your guests by serving your quiche with warm rustic bread and a salad bowl of mixed leaves with an olive oil, cider vinegar, mustard and black pepper dressing.

Teatime by Lynn can also provide rich Chocolate and Carrot and Walnut Gateaux, desserts such as Pecan Pie and Lemon Tart, classic filled sponges such as Victoria Sandwich Cake, great Yorkshire icons like our renowned Yorkshire Curd Tart or rich Brandy Fruitcake, tea-

## Win bed and breakfast for two at West Winds...


